We are thrilled to have been selected by the Co-op Local Community fund to be one of their charities this year.

It's what we do

The Co-op's ethos promotes togetherness and community support, which reflects our mission at Hextol. The opportunities we offer to work for our customers in a supportive environment allows our volunteers to make a positive contribution to their local communities, while helping to reduce social isolation and improve self-esteem.

We will be promoted in the Hexham, Ponteland and Corbridge stores, as well as Co-op Funeralcare, to raise money for gardening and kitchen equipment, as well as general support for the Tans and gardening teams.

Co-op Causes works like this...members can choose their local cause and it costs £1 to join the Co-op. 1% of a member's spending on Co-op branded products goes to their chosen local cause; 1% goes to an 'Altogether Fairer' Fund which supports national causes (often linked to food poverty or education causes for young people); and 2% goes as a personal reward to the member.

We have worked extremely hard this year to continue to offer working opportunities and support to as many of our volunteers as we can, despite COVID restrictions and it's great to see others doing the same. This year, the Co-op have doubled their contributions to their community funds and their selected charities will receive donations for the next 12 months. This continued support from all of our funders is essential for us to continue to do what we do best.
