## What will I be doing?



Joining our team of volunteer gardeners will help you to learn new skills in many areas, like mowing, pruning, weeding and leaf clearing.

You will be looking after gardens in people's homes, offices and schools. At the end of each shift you will help clean the equipment and store it safely.

We will not ask you to do any jobs that you are not confident about, and there will be a Supervisor at every shift who will be able to help you if needed.

## Where will I be working?

We have gardening teams in Hexham, and also in Newcastle.

Our Hexham team are based in our Gilesgate office and work in gardens around the local area.

Our Newcastle team is based in Fenham.

Transport, equipment, safety clothing and personal protective equipment is all provided.



To work in gardening, you need to:

- Listen to and follow instructions, and not be afraid to ask questions
- Be polite to customers and the people you work with
- Be fit enough for physical work
- Wear appropriate safety clothing and equipment
